Top music events in north-west Germany –

The 28th Bremen Music Festival begins on 19 August 2017

The **28th Bremen Music Festival** promises to be a sensational show, featuring famous classical works as well as rarely heard gems spanning a range of eras, genres and cultures. Running from **19 August to 9 September**, the programme of **38 events** held across **29 venues** in Bremen, Bremerhaven and other select locations around north-west Germany will showcase big names and up-and-coming talents. The live, authentic and intimate performances will be music to your ears! The festival opens with **Eine grosse Nachtmusik**, an ever-popular evening of 27 wide-ranging concerts held in three separate time slots around the beautifully illuminated market square – home to Bremen’s UNESCO World Heritage Town Hall and Roland statue. As part of the extensive programme, the **Arp Schnitger Festival** once again highlights the world-class reputation of Bremen and the surrounding region for organ-making and organ music. Meanwhile, over in the Überseestadt district the **Music Festival Surprise** series offers a lucky dip of unconventional concerts. Whether symphonic, choral, chamber, jazz or world music, the festival presents masters of the genres who have delighted Bremen audiences in previous years, such as **Fazil Say, Philippe Herreweghe, Kristjan Järvi & Absolute Ensemble**, the **Metropole Orkest**, **Kurt Elling, Dee Dee Bridgewater** and **Daniil Trifonov**. There will also be plenty of acts who are new to the festival, including **Igor Levit, David Zinman, Mischa Maisky** and **Khatia Buniatishvili**.
