National Geographic's Global Editorial Teams profiled Slovenia among **25 Most Extraordinary Places and Communities To Inspire Your Next Trip** in the "Nature" category. As such, Slovenia is **one of the eight European destinations** that made to the list of 25 selected destinations. In the description, **Slovenia Green Gourmet Route** was highlighted, a tourism product of sustainable cycling and gastronomic experiences, which was developed in partnership with **the Slovenia Green consortium** and **the Slovenian Tourist Board** in 2021, when Slovenia proudly held the title of **the European Region of Gastronomy**.
