Ryanair, Belgium's no.1 airline, today (17 Jan) announced its Summer 2023 schedule from its 2 Brussels airports (Charleroi & Zaventem) with 5 new routes from Charleroi to sunshine hotspots like Asturias and Nantes, as well as exciting city destinations like Cluj, Iasi and Lodz.

Ryanair's Brussels Summer 2023 schedule will deliver:

- 16 based aircraft (\$1.6bn invest) in Charleroi
- 5 new routes from Charleroi to Asturias, Cluj, Iasi, Lodz and Nantes
- 121 total routes to/from Brussels
- Increased freq. on 30+ popular routes, incl. Dublin, Girona, Malaga, Milan, Pisa, and Turin
- Supporting over 7,000 jobs, incl. almost 500 highly paid pilot & cabin crew jobs

The addition of one new based aircraft at Charleroi (from 15 to 16) for 2023 – another \$100m investment – shows Ryanair's commitment to growth and recovery for Belgium, which has consistently enjoyed Ryanair's efficient, low-cost operations over the last 25+ years.

As confirmed last week, Ryanair will not re-open its Zaventem base for S2023 due to Zaventem's decision to raise prices by 11% in 2023, while many other EU airports are lowering prices to recover traffic lost during Covid (or are freezing charges to stimulate passenger growth). Ryanair will continue to operate 12 high frequency routes to/from Zaventem on aircraft based outside Belgium in its Brussels S2023 schedule.
