

Royal Jordanian Airlines Launches New Route between Amman and Brussels

- RJ will offer twice-weekly flights, every Thursday and Sunday, between Jordan's capital and Brussels, Belgium from Queen Alia International Airport in Amman, Jordan and Brussels Airport International Airport in Brussels, Belgium
- RJ to build one of the largest networks in the levant with its five years growth plan

Brussels – *April 06, 2023* – As part of the airline's strategic plans to expand its global network and welcome new visitors to the Kingdom, Royal Jordanian (RJ) has announced a new direct route between Amman, Jordan and Brussels, Belgium beginning October 26. RJ will begin operating twice-weekly flights between the two capital cities allowing passengers to travel from Belgium to Jordan, and vice versa, in just around four to five hours.
