The **Trans Dinarica**, launching in 2024, is the first bicycle route connecting the Western Balkans. The moderately difficult, 3364km (2090-mile) trail weaves through **Slovenia, Croatia, Bosnia and Hercegovina, Montenegro, Albania, North Macedonia, Kosovo** and **Serbia**, and spotlights mountain ranges, the Adriatic Sea, numerous lakes and rivers while prioritizing sustainable exploration of Unesco sites, national parks and villages.
