

European Sleeper introduces a dining car on the Night Train Brussel – Amsterdam – Berlin – Prague

In Autumn 2024, European Sleeper is thrilled to introduce an exclusive dining car on its international night train. This anticipated feature, made possible through recent investments in European Sleeper shares, will pilot from September 1 to November 1, 2024. This positions European Sleeper as one of the few night trains in Europe offering such amenities. The success of this pilot could see the dining car become a permanent offering on the European Sleeper service.



European Sleeper is one of the few privately owned international train operators in Europe. The company has operated a night train between Brussels, Amsterdam, and Berlin since the end of May 2023, which has recently been extended to Dresden and Prague. Since the start of the operations, European Sleeper has been transporting over 55,000 passengers in more than 260 trains.

About European Sleeper European Sleeper is a 100% community-owned cooperative. The company funded its seed capital by selling shares worth €5,000,000 to more than 3,500 smaller investors. The most recent investments

are dedicated to the dining car pilot project and the next €50,000 will be spent on the livery of the night train carriages. In the current round, more than 70% of the shares worth €1,000,000 have been sold and the remaining shares are expected to be sold soon. The funds will be used to further improve the quality of the trains and to prepare for the new European Sleeper night train between Amsterdam, Brussels and Barcelona.
